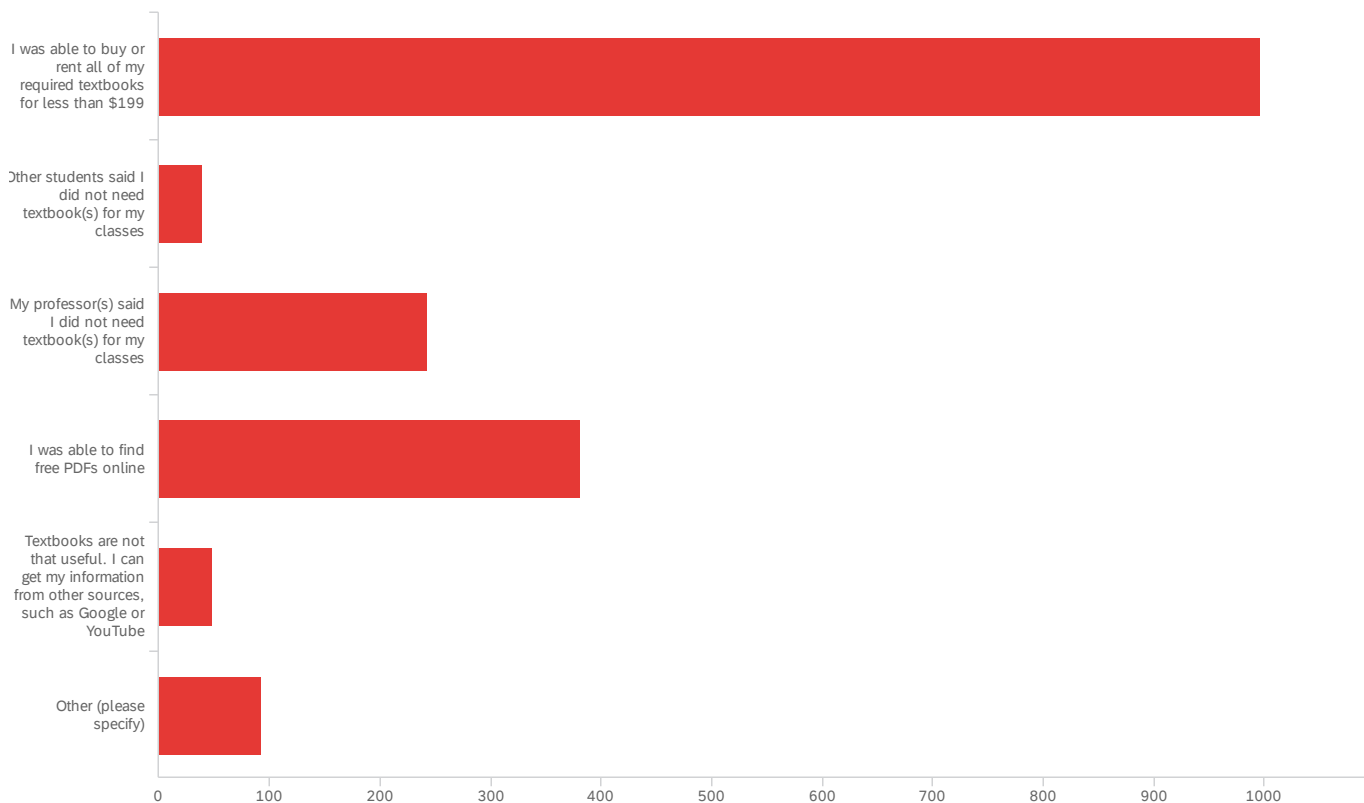

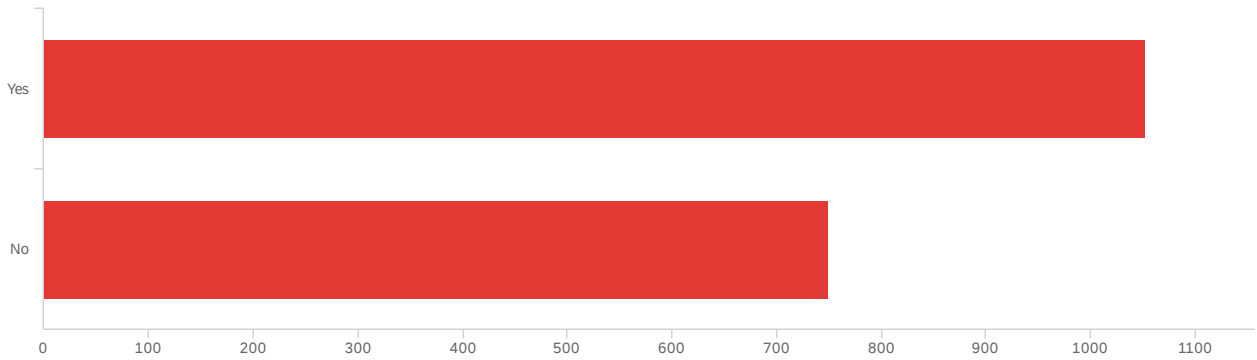
## Q1 - What was your primary reason for opting out of Equitable Access?

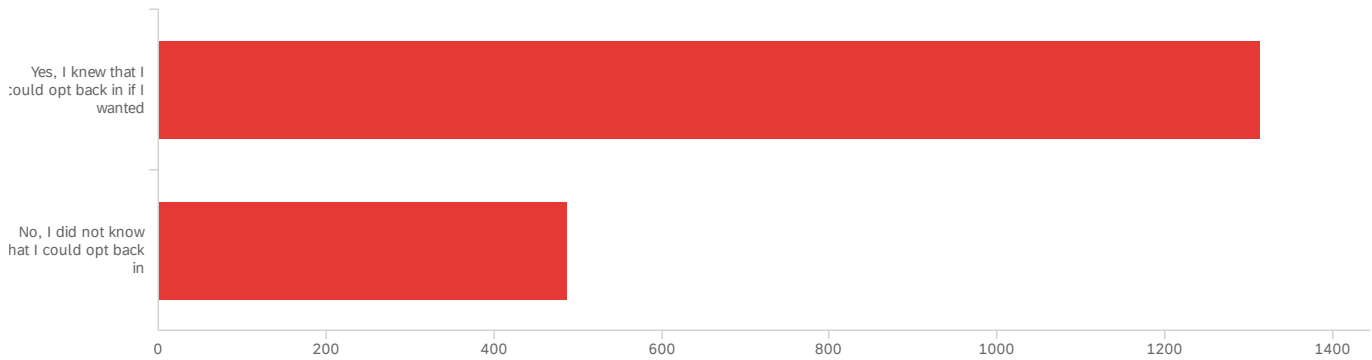
